Make the most of the summer break and enjoy this time with your children.

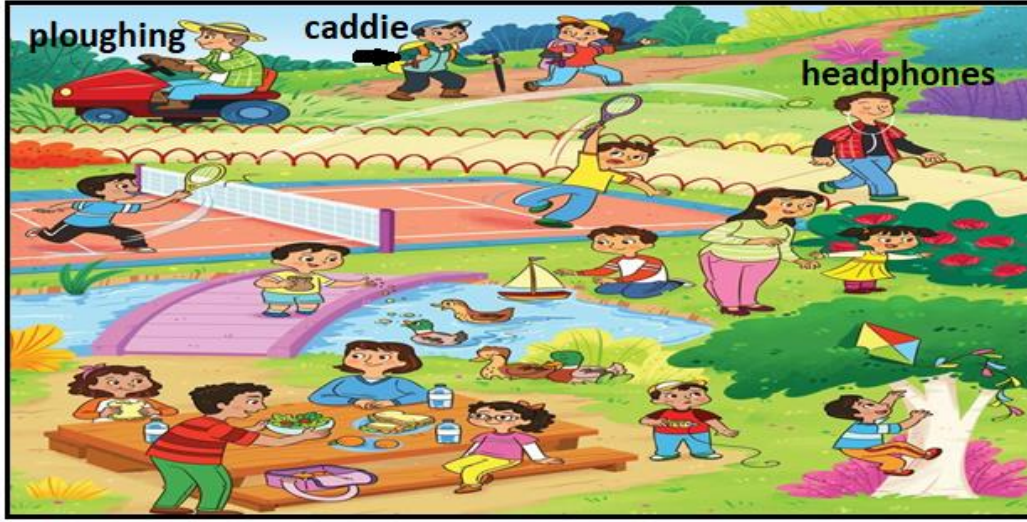
