ACTIVITY- 1

i. Childhood Memories of Mumma & Papa – “When They Were Little”

Objective:

To strengthen family bonding, develop listening and speaking skills, and help children connect with their parents' childhood experiences.

Instructions:

- Parents will share one funny or happy childhood memory with their child.
- Show old photographs, toys, storybooks, or talk about games you played when you were little.
- Teach your child one simple childhood game like stapoo, hide & seek, or skipping.
- Encourage your child to ask questions and talk about the story.

Fun Twist:

Click a “Then & Now” picture with the parent and child together and paste it in the scrapbook.

Objective:

To develop self-help skills, hand coordination, and confidence through everyday tasks.

Suggested Activities:

- Folding small napkins or clothes
- Watering plants with a small mug
- Arranging toys in a basket
- Wiping the table with a cloth

Fun Twist:

Give your child a “Super Helper” Star badge after completing the tasks.

Click pictures while your child is helping at home and paste them in the scrapbook.

ACTIVITY- 2

Story Picnic Time – Read, Imagine & Pretend

Objective:

To develop listening skills, imagination, vocabulary, and confidence through interactive storytelling.

Instructions:

- Spread a mat or blanket and create a cosy “Story Picnic Corner” at home.
- Read 2–3 picture books together for 10–15 minutes daily.
- Encourage your child to observe pictures, repeat funny words, and guess what happens next.
- Ask simple questions like:
 - “Who do you like the most?”
 - “What was funny?”
 - “What would you do in the story?”

Story Fun Twist:

Let your child become their favourite story character by wearing simple props, making funny expressions, or acting out a small scene from the story.

Click a picture during story time or role play and paste it in the scrapbook.

- Star Pose

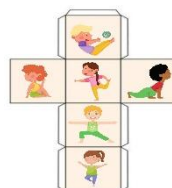


Instructions:

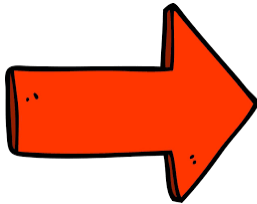
