ACTIVITY – 2

Book Buddy Theatre

Objective:

To develop imagination, vocabulary, speaking confidence, and listening skills through interactive reading and role play.

Instructions:

- Choose one favourite picture storybook and read it together with your child.
- Encourage your child to observe pictures, repeat dialogues, and make funny expressions.
- Help your child act like one character from the story using simple props or actions.
- Ask simple questions like:
 - “Which character did you like the most?”
 - “What happened in the story?”
 - “Can you make the character’s voice?”

Story Fun Twist:

Create a small “Story Stage” using cushions, dupattas, or soft toys and enjoy a mini story performance at home.

Let your child dress up as their favourite character, enact the story, and narrate it in their own words. Record the performance and share it with the class teacher.

Click pictures during story reading or role play and paste them in the scrapbook.

Instructions:

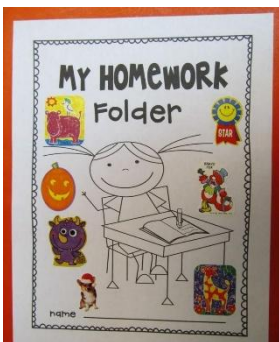
- Let your child decorate the folder with drawings, smileys, stars, handprints, or favourite cartoon doodles.

- Encourage them to say why plants and trees are important for us.

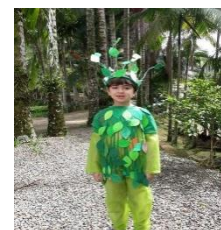
Fun Twist:

Fun Twist:

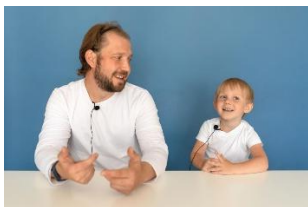
Use a spoon, toy mic, or hairbrush as a “microphone” and enjoy a mini family talk show at home.

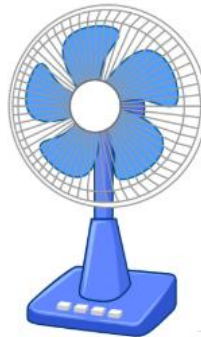

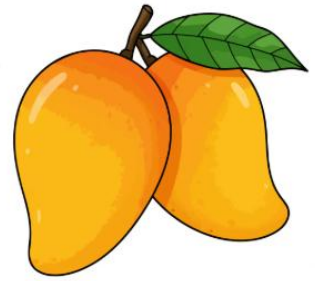

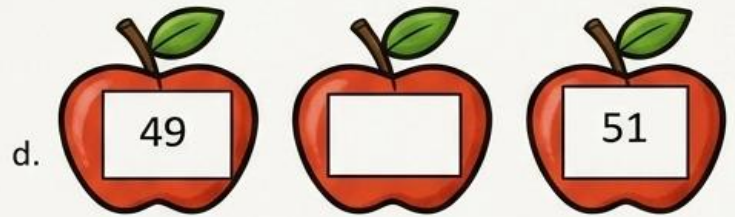
